

## Timeline for water fluoridation in Queensland

Water fluoridation will be phased into water treatment plants in the following local government areas (incorporating the new boundaries)

2009	South East Queensland minor water treatment plants, Gold Coast Desalination Plant, Indigenous communities, commencement of Cairns (partial), Gladstone (partial) Mackay (partial), Rockhampton (partial) and Toowoomba.	80%
2010	Completion of Cairns, Gladstone, Mackay and Rockhampton; Fraser Coast, Gympie, South Burnett, Southern Downs, and continue Toowoomba.	83%
2011	Blackall-Tambo, Central Highlands, Dalby, Goondiwindi, Hinchinbrook, Longreach, Mount Isa, Murweh, North Burnett, Rio Tinto (Weipa), Tablelands and Whitsunday.	92%
2012	Balonne, Banana, Barcaldine, Bundaberg, Burdekin, Cassowary, Carpenteria, Charters Towers, Cloncurry, Cook, Flinders, Isaac, Paroo, Roma, Winton, Townsville and completion of Toowoomba.	95%
