



# Superannuation Entitlements for Employees 70 Years and Over

## Human Resources Policy

Effective Date: May 2008

### 1 PURPOSE

To advise that the Director-General has determined under Section 28 of the *Health Services Act 1991* that the Superannuation Entitlements for Certain Employees Directive No. 12/07 also applies to employees who are 70 years of age and over employed under Sections 24 and 28 of the *Health Services Act 1991*, effective from 1 July 2007.

### 2 APPLICATION

This HR policy applies to employees who are over 70 years of age and employed under:

- Sections 24 and 28 of the *Health Services Act 1991*
- *Public Service Act 1996*

### 3 GUIDELINES

Guidelines may be developed to facilitate implementation of this policy. The guidelines must be consistent with this policy.

### 4 DELEGATION

The “delegate” is as listed in the Queensland Health Human Resource Delegations Manual as amended from time to time.
