<b>ALLOCATION OF PRIORITY GROUPS</b>	
Applicants eligible for an internship in Queensland will be considered for available intern positions in the following order of priority:	
<b>Priority Category</b>	<b>Definition of Applicant Priority</b>
1	Medical graduates of Queensland universities who are Australian citizens or permanent residents (guaranteed a placement offer).
2	Medical graduates of interstate/New Zealand universities who completed Year 12 in Queensland and are Australian citizens or permanent residents.
3	Medical graduates of interstate/New Zealand universities who are Australian citizens or permanent residents.
* 4	Medical graduates of Queensland universities who are overseas citizens or permanent residents permitted to remain in Australia for internship.
* 5	Medical graduates of interstate/New Zealand universities who are overseas citizens or permanent residents permitted to remain in Australia for internship.
6	Australian Medical Council (AMC) graduates who are Australian citizens or permanent residents and require a year of supervised training to meet general registration requirements of the Medical Board of Queensland.
7	Medical graduates of international universities who are Australian citizens or permanent residents.
* 8	Medical graduates of international universities who are overseas citizens or permanent residents.

NB: \* Overseas citizens or permanent residents include NZ citizens or permanent residents.
