Acceptable approaches include, but are not limited to, the use of human volunteers, epidemiology, certain human cell lines, certain human tissue or cells <i>in vitro</i> , certain micro-organisms, sub-cellular components <i>in vitro</i> , pharmacokinetic modelling and computer technology (<i>in silico</i>).
Eligibility	Applicants should normally hold a Bachelor Degree in Science or Medicine or an equivalent qualification, be studying for an Honours Degree and must be Australian Citizens.
