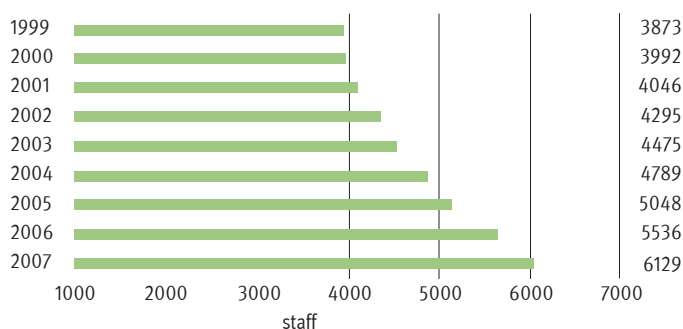
### Page 19 **Number of new patients waiting table**
