

Queensland Health Action Plan Progress Report For Clinical Occupational Streams - July 2009

Reporting Period: Last pay period of the month June 2005 and July 2009

Notes: The data is a report against the targets set for Medical, Nursing and Health Practitioners / Professional / Technical (formally Allied Health / Professionals / Scientists) stream growth. The Health Practitioners stream includes redesignated staff from the Allied Health, Scientists and Technical streams. The figures are headcounts of Active (paid normally in a fortnight) and Paid (on paid leave) staff. It excludes those staff on extended unpaid leave.

Summary:

The December 2006 Targets have been **well exceeded** ie: by **1,809** medical officers (target 300), **7,233** nurses (target 500) and **2,402** Health Practitioners / Professional / Technical officers (target 400).
