*Overall management and control of Tuberculosis (and associated mycobacterial diseases) including:*

- Medical services to support diagnosis and management of Tuberculosis and other mycobacterial diseases
- Medical follow-up of migrants with Tuberculosis Undertakings or Health Undertakings
- Home and hospital visits for tuberculosis patients for the duration of TB treatment
- Monitoring and supervision of tuberculosis medication
- Tuberculosis contact tracing and screening service for TB contacts
- Tuberculosis screening for pre-employment, health workers including university students, overseas travelers, self-referrals
- Medical follow-up/referral of clients with significant tuberculin test (Mantoux) results
- Migrant Tuberculosis Health Screening (including serological screening for Hep B)
- Tuberculosis clinical work-up for Australian Permanent Residency applicants
- Neonatal/babies BCG clinic 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesdays of month by appointment
- Other BCG vaccination sessions Mondays and Thursdays
- Educational sessions for health care & education facilities as requested
