

### 3. Outputs/Major Activities of the Department

As a consequence of the whole of Government Shared Service Initiative, the following transfers of asset and liabilities to other reporting entities occurred:

- From 1 July 2003, Queensland Health's SAP systems team transferred to CorpTech (hosted by Treasury Department). The value of assets transferred was \$14.761 million which consisted mainly of the system software transferred. A liability of \$0.315 million was transferred for staff annual leave balances.
- From 1 December 2003, existing corporate service functions within Queensland Health transferred to QHSSP. The value of assets transferred was \$37.274 million which consisted mainly of system software transferred and cash balances to satisfy staff leave balances. A liability of \$8.757 million was transferred for staff annual leave balances.

The identity and purpose of each output/major activity undertaken by Queensland Health during the year is summarised below:

#### **Acute Inpatient Services**

Hospital-based medical and surgical treatment services for admitted patients, linked to community-based treatment support services.

#### **Non-Inpatient Services**

Hospital-based emergency treatment and integrated services for non-admitted patients, including community-based services.

#### **Health Maintenance Services**

Services provided in dedicated facilities and a community-based, full service network of rehabilitation and home care services for frail older people and people with intellectual and physical disabilities; and hospital and community-based convalescent, rehabilitation, respite and palliative care services.

#### **Integrated Mental Health Services**

Inpatient, outpatient and community-based mental health services.

#### **Public Health Services**

Integrated population-wide responses to the promotion and protection of health and well-being and the prevention of disease, illness and injury.
