## Graduate Certificate and Masters of Forensic Mental Health

### Course Aims

- Partnership between Queensland Health and Griffith University has led to the development of a graduate certificate and masters of forensic mental health.
- On-line education for mental health professionals and graduate students.
- Examine the social, legal, ethical and clinical issues that are specific to forensic mental health and which impact on clinical practice.

### Course Benefits

- On-line delivery results in convenient study options (study at home and work).
- Short-term study commitment (one year part time for the graduate certificate, two years part time for the masters).
- Acquire advanced skills in risk assessment & management of forensic clients as well as other issues specific to forensic mental health.

### Enrolment Details

- Programs commenced in 2004 for domestic students.
- Requires enrolment through Griffith University.
- Applicants must possess a relevant undergraduate degree, or equivalent (eg. Hospital based nursing training and minimum 5 years experience).
- Substantial benefits available for Queensland Health Employees, such as eligibility for the Q.H. scholarship scheme (2/3 of course fees subsidised).
