

Queensland Basic Physician Training (Adult Medicine) Network

Planning for continuation of Physician Training

All applicants wishing to undertake basic physician training in Queensland must join the Basic Physician Training (Adult Medicine) Network. All network trainees will be allocated training placements geared towards preparing for exams in the third year on the network. Support to sit the exam before this time will be considered on a case by case basis" in consideration of training capacity and available exam preparation resources. Applicants looking to join the network to CONTINUE TRAINING are required to:

- Consider which [network rotation](#) may best suit their needs. * Note that some rotations may be better placed to accommodate an earlier examination attempt AND
- Contact the relevant Network Rotation Coordinator (NRC) to discuss your training requirements and proposed examination plans AND
- Ensure this form is signed by an NRC during or soon after meeting AND
- Upload the signed form (as evidence) as part of your RMO Campaign application.
