Selection to the SET program in Cardiothoracic Surgery in Australian and New Zealand are managed by the [Royal Australasian College of Surgeons](#) (RACS). Applicants need to apply directly to RACS for a [training position in General Surgery](#).

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued by your allocated training facility, applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an application via the [RMO Campaign applicant portal](#).

RMO application: Step 10 Preferences

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, to be considered you **MUST** complete your preference by entering the following:
