

# KINGAROY HOSPITAL UPDATE

## Changes to services

On Wednesday 2 December a range of our inpatient services are scheduled to start in the new building of Stage 1 of the Kingaroy Hospital Redevelopment.

We want to ensure you have all the information needed to navigate your way around our new building. Please see below for more details.

### What services are in the new building?

Ground floor:

- Emergency Department
- Medical Imaging (x-ray)
- Pathology
- Pharmacy

First Floor:

- Inpatient wards (medical, surgical and paediatric)
- Maternity and birthing suites
- Theatres and day procedures

Specialist outpatients, cardiac rehabilitation and patient travel will be located in the Annexe building, near the public car park and Allied Health building.

Our Renal Unit, Oral Health and Community Health services will continue to operate from their current locations.

### Where do we enter the new building?

Entry during business hours will be via a walkway on the south-eastern side of the new building. After hours entry will be via an entry on the western side of the building, adjacent to the Renal Unit, through the new Emergency Department.

There will be plenty of signage and lighting around these entrances.

### Are there changes to car parking?

Car parking arrangements stay the same with access to the hospital, Mental Health, Allied Health and the annexe from Albert Street, and access to Oral Health and Community Health from Youngman Street.

### Is there more to do on the project?

With Stage 1 complete we will now be moving onto Stage 2. Site fencing will be put up around the old hospital building. In the New Year construction will start for Stage 2 of the project which will include an expanded Renal Unit and improved specialist outpatient service. Stage 2 is scheduled to be finished, and the project fully completed by late 2021.
