

Declaration and COVID-19 testing for Freight and Logistics Operators entering QLD

Have you been in a **QLD declared Affected Area** in the last 14 days?



Freight and Logistics (F Pass) required every time you enter Queensland after being in an Affected Area.

Mandatory: If you left the confines of your vehicle in an **Affected Area**, you must have a **negative COVID test result within 7 days** before entering QLD, and be able to provide evidence. In addition, you must have evidence of a **COVID-19 test taken in the 72 hours immediately prior to entering QLD.**

Maintain a rolling **3-day routine testing cycle until you leave QLD** or 14 days have passed since you were in an Affected Area, whichever is shorter.

Must be able to show evidence of COVID-19 test/s.

Have you been in a **QLD declared COVID-19 hotspot**, in the last 14 days or since the **identified start date** for the QLD declared COVID-19 hotspot, whichever is shorter?



Freight and Logistics (F Pass).

Mandatory: You must have a **negative COVID test result within 7 days** before entering QLD.

Maintain rolling **7-day routine testing cycle** when travelling in/out of QLD declared COVID-19 hotspots.

Must be able to show evidence of COVID-19 test/s.

Queensland and New South Wales border zone residents who are freight and logistics operators, **who have only/ explicitly been in the NSW border zone in the last 14 days?**



Border Zone Travel (X Pass).

Do not need to undertake the seven day rolling testing cycle when traveling in and out of the NSW border zone into Queensland.

Entering Queensland when you **haven't been in a Queensland declared COVID-19 hotspot (including the NSW Border Zone)?**



Queensland Entry Pass (T Pass).
