

Acute Resuscitation Plans via The Viewer

June 2023

The Health Provider Portal (HPP) provides Queensland’s eligible health practitioners with secure online access to their patient’s Queensland Health records.

This read-only online access allows health practitioners to view public hospital information including appointment records, radiology and pathology reports, treatment and discharge summaries, demographic, and medication details.

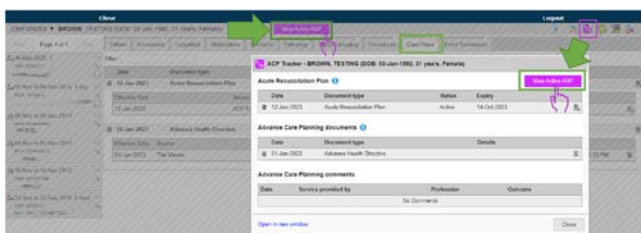
Acute Resuscitation Plans

Acute Resuscitation Plans (ARPs) and Paediatric Acute Resuscitation Plans (PARPs) can be captured by one of the following ways and display in the ACP Tracker:

1. Direct entry into the ACP Tracker by an authorised Queensland Health clinician (outside of an ieMR site)
2. Created in integrated electronic Medical Record (ieMR) from 5 June 2023 and automatically transferred to the ACP Tracker
3. Paper copy (from private facilities and residential care facilities) uploaded into the ACP Tracker by the Statewide Office of Advance Care Planning.

How can I access the information?

HPP users can view the forms by selecting the ‘View Active ARP/PARP’ icon via the patient banner, the ACP Tracker, and the Care Plans tab through normal login means:

Discharge summaries created at Queensland Health facilities will reference if ARP and/or ACP documents have been created during the patient’s admission:

What is The Viewer?

The Viewer is a Queensland Health (QH) web-based application that collates comprehensive data from multiple QH health systems. It provides health professionals with access to real-time vital clinical information regardless of where the staff member or patient is located within the state.

What is the Advance Care Planning (ACP) Tracker?

The ACP Tracker is an information sharing portal located within The Viewer that enables direct and easy access to advance care planning documents and information across service settings to support provision of quality end-of-life care.
