## RMO Campaign 2023

The **Queensland Anaesthetic Rotational Training Scheme** (pronounced 'quartz') oversees the four (4) Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetics (ANZCA) accredited rotations in Queensland in accordance with ANZCA's Regulation 37 and the Handbook for Training and Accreditation.

## Preference QARTS Rotations

QARTS is divided into four groups of rotations, termed Central, Gold Coast, Northern and Southern. In each rotation there are Core, Metropolitan and Regional facilities. QARTS registrars are expected to accept the rotation they are offered.

There are also accredited anaesthetic positions with LifeFlight, the positions offered are suitable for 4th or 5th year trainees with a special interest in retrieval or military medicine. 
