In Queensland, selection to advanced training in Medical Oncology is managed centrally by the **Queensland Medical Oncology Training Network**. The network manages the recruitment, selection and allocation of new and continuing trainees to accredited training sites.

RMO Application: Step 10 Preferences

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, applicants who wish to apply to the training program **MUST** complete their 1st preference as follows:

What is your first preferred facility? *	College/Pathway/Network (Determined)
What is your first preferred position? *	Registrar
What is your first preferred Specialty? *	Medicine
What is your first preferred Sub-Specialty? *	Medical Oncology (AT)

Up to 5 preferences may be recorded as part of the application, preferences 2-5 should be alternative options in the event you are NOT selected to a training position. You can search for alternative vacancies by using the [Position search tool](#) on the RMO website.
