DO YOU WORK IN THE AGED CARE OR DISABILITY SECTORS? WOULD YOU LIKE TO IMPROVE YOUR INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS?

The Queensland Government is offering subsidised training in infection control to people working in the aged care and disability sectors including personal care, lifestyle support, cleaning and food service staff, at no cost to the applicant.

Successful applicants will complete the Unit of Study *HLTINF001 Comply with infection control policies and procedures* and receive a certificate of completion. Initially, six (6) pilot programs will be conducted in the Sunshine Coast, Brisbane and Gold Coast regions commencing in December 2020 and further programs will be offered in 2021.
