

# Administration of COVID-19 vaccine during an admitted episode of care

## Queensland Hospital Admitted Patient Data Collection (QHAPDC)

Where a patient receives a COVID-19 vaccine (first and/or second dose) during an admitted episode of care the following ICD-10-AM and ACHI codes are to be assigned:

- Z25.8 *Need for immunisation against other specified single viral diseases*
- 92157-00 *Vaccination against viral diseases, not elsewhere classified.*



Australian Coding Standard 1500 *Diagnosis sequencing in obstetric episodes of care* specifically specifies the requirement for the assigning of codes for prophylactic vaccination/need for immunisation.

Condition onset flag (COF): The assignment of the COF value for Z25.8 *Need for immunisation against other specified single viral diseases* should be assigned according to the circumstances relating to the vaccination.

## Example

Patient X is admitted to the Rehabilitation Unit post unilateral knee replacement for osteoarthritis (Care type 20 Rehabilitation) for ongoing physiotherapy. The patient had already had the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine prior to admission and is now due the second dose. The treating clinician confirms that the patient is to receive the second COVID-19 dose during the admitted episode of care. The COVID-19 vaccine is administered on 20 April 2021 with no vaccine reaction. The patient has no history of having had COVID-19.
