Patient has left sided weakness and wasn't able to hold a smile for 30 seconds, QFRS was called for help extrication due to patient living in a high set home, partner also stated patient had approximately 6 beers throughout the day as well,

Examination: Pt was able to respond when spoken to and try and talk to QAS officers, patient had left sided weakness, couldn't push or pull or hold a smile for a good 30 seconds, when asked if patient had any chest pain or tightness before episode, patient also c/o 10/10 pain behind right eye in which was a sudden onset when episode started, p3pearl, patient had good rise and fall of chest, patient c/o pin and needle to whole left arm as well, patient's skin was sweaty on scene and patient felt hot. Review:

This review has considered the incident, and events immediately pre and post the incident, per the file notes and statements provided by the parties to the incident.

This review has also considered the findings of the ECLIPSE review and the treatment or care received by the patient against QAS Clinical Practice Guidelines and Procedures.

This review will evaluate the application of QAS incident notification practices as per the relevant SOPs and guidelines.

Upon review:

- The QAS stretcher and hospital bed were not aligned side-by-side or "squared-up".

 The restraint straps were removed from the patient.
- The side-rail of the stretcher was lowered.
- It is alleged only one wheel brake was engaged.
- Application of a RAT test on the patient on the QAS stretcher may have contributed to the untimely movement of the unsecured patient and may not have been communicated effectively prior.
- QAS Officers state they had their backs to the patient during the incident.
- Per the CPP Clinical Handover and QAS Manual Tasking procedures, best practice patient handover was not adhered to.
- Communication, command and control during handover was not best practice.
- Patient sustained an injury to their neck during the fall.
- The attending QAS paramedics failed to advise the duty SOS or OpCen of the incident. As this incident involved an injury to a patient, OpCen Operations - Notification of QAS Senior Officers

SOP advises that injuries to patients or their families while in the care of the QAS, that require medical attention, is a notifiable incident. This incident would have met this requirement and should have been reported by the attending QAS paramedics ASAP.

- The Workplace Health and Safety Policy Statement outlines that all WHS incidents, resulting or having potential to result in harm to a QAS worker or other person states that, all workers are required to:
 - Report all near misses and actual harm in the SHE system, as soon as practicable after a WHS incident.

 - o The attending QAS paramedics failed to comply with this policy.

- Further information obtained revealed the second car involved had two persons trapped both conscious and breathing

At 15:53, two units were dispatched from Moranbah, this crewing was later reconfigured to be only responding in unit 2299. Mackay Rescue 412 was assigned to this case at 15:58. A second unit from Nebo was assigned at 16:07 (Officer on days off and the Assistant Commissioner who was completing a District tour).

Patient 1 Irrelevant was said to be "difficult access due to the excessive damage to the vehicle and the patient being pinned between the front seat and rear seat in a ball position. Irrelevant Irrelevant

Irrelevant QAS personnel and bystanders did attempt to extricate Irrelevant from the vehicle but stated that due Irrelevant vehicle damage they were unable to. This patient died at 1632hours while still in the vehicle. QFES did not arrive on scene until 1637hours. ROLE was conpleted and Irrelevant was left with QPS.

Due to the previous case, 15439307, Irrelevant and Officer Irrelevant (Rostered on 09:00-21:00) were at Mackay Base Hospital at the time of this incident, and did not complete this case until 23:02 hours.

Prior to Officer Irrelevantarriving on scene, QPS had given a sitrep that there was a large fire on both sides of the road (highway) and that the incident was directly under power lines and affecting these. Officer Irrelevant in Unit 2128 was the first QAS unit on scene at 22:13 hours and gave a sitrep confirming that two vehicles were completely engulfed in flames, multiple bystanders were on scene and people were walking around – stating at this time that he was unsure of the number of patients involved and to continue all backup Code 1.

At 22:16 hours, QFES arrived on scene and ERGON were isolating the power lines. Officer Irrelevant gave another sitrep at 22:21 stating that he had identified only one patient as any other occupants of the vehicles involved had been incinerated. At 2246 hours Officer Irrelevant rom Unit 2501 confirmed a single Signal 4 occupant of the now burnt out utility.

A transport plan was devised by the crews on scene, including utilising QPS to take Unit 2501 to Mackay Base Hospital so Officer Irrelevant accompany Officer Irrelevant in the care of Patient 1. Officer Irrelevant

remained on scene with other services until the highway was able to be reopened, departing scene at 23:01 hours.




