Mental Health Act (MHA) 2016, Sections 80, 81

- An authorised doctor must give written notice to the Chief Psychiatrist of the following in relation to a classified patient:
 - an assessment period for the person ends, a treatment authority is not made for the person and the person does not consent to continue to receive treatment and care as classified patient (voluntary);
 - the person's treatment authority, forensic order (mental health) or treatment support order is revoked, the Mental Health Review Tribunal does not make another authority or order for the person and the person does not consent to continue to receive treatment and care as classified patient (voluntary);
 - a classified patient (voluntary) withdraws consent to remaining in an authorised mental health service (AMHS) and a treatment authority is not made;
 - an authorised doctor is satisfied it is not clinically appropriate for the person to receive treatment and care for the person's mental illness in an AMHS.

- Treatment authority, forensic order (mental health) or treatment support order has been revoked, no other order or authority has been made, and the person has not become a classified patient (voluntary)
- Classified patient (voluntary) has withdrawn consent and no treatment authority has been made
- Person is no longer in lawful custody (e.g. period of imprisonment ended, bail granted, charges discontinued)
- It is no longer clinically appropriate for the person to receive treatment and care in an AMHS (*provide reasons*)

Return of Classified Patient to Custody, Sections 82-83

The Chief Psychiatrist must give written notice to:

- the Administrator of the AMHS where the person was admitted
- the Administrator of the referring service
- the custodian, and
- the Chief Executive (Justice) (if the person is charged with an offence or awaiting sentencing).

Within one (1) day after receiving the Chief Psychiatrist's notice, the custodian must make arrangements for an authorised person to take the patient from the AMHS into the custodian's custody.
