Mental Health Act (MHA) 2016, Chapter 4 Part 2

- A psychiatrist report can be requested for a person who:
 - » is charged with a serious offence; and
 - » was on a treatment authority, forensic order or treatment support order at the time of the offence or any later time.
- A 'serious offence' is an indictable offence but does not include an indictable offence that must be heard by a Magistrate.
- The psychiatrist report will address the serious offence and any associated offence(s). An 'associated offence' is an offence that occurred at or around the same time as the serious offence.
