Creating an account

Note for prior Cunningham Centre students

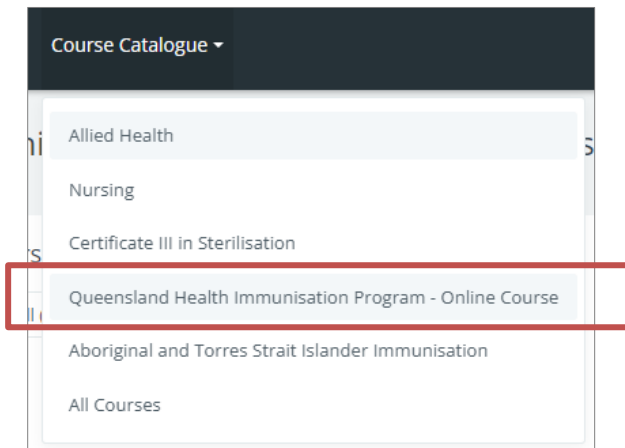

Enrolment key

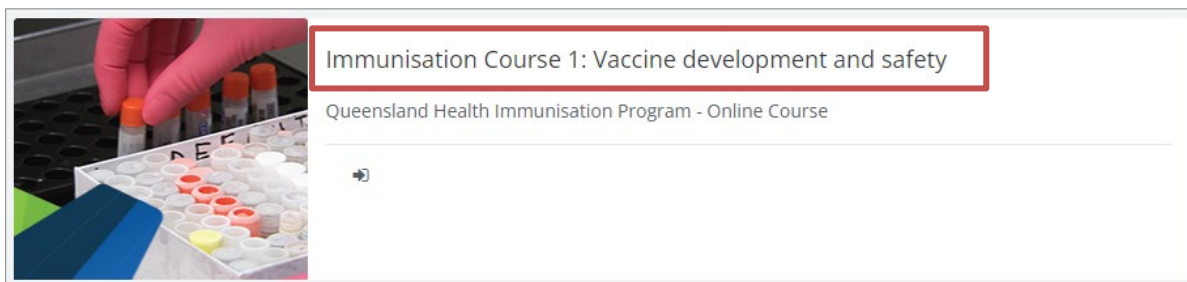
Once your account has been created, you will see a message telling you that you have been enrolled into the 4 QHIP courses.

Navigating to the courses

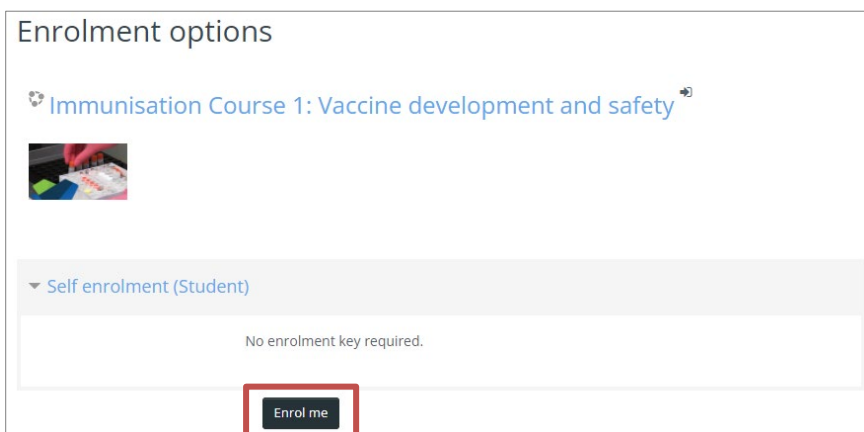
Click “Course Catalogue” in the top menu bar, then select “Queensland Health Immunisation Program – Online Course”.

This online course provides a comprehensive overview of the complex and ever-changing topic of immunisation for those who receipt, administer, or manage vaccines in Queensland.

The course also contains information about the history of vaccines and their importance in reducing vaccine preventable disease. You will also learn about vaccine development, safety and ongoing surveillance, the components that make up vaccines, and how to respond to concerns of vaccine hesitant patients.

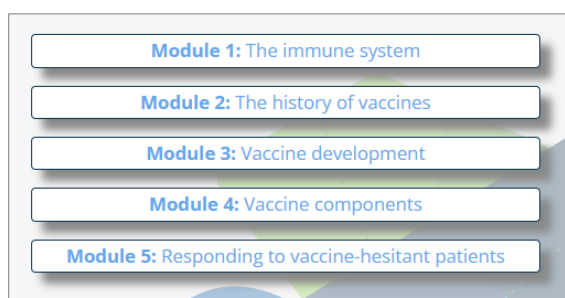
Once you have completed the survey and acknowledged the disclaimer you will be returned to the course homepage where the elearning modules will now be accessible.

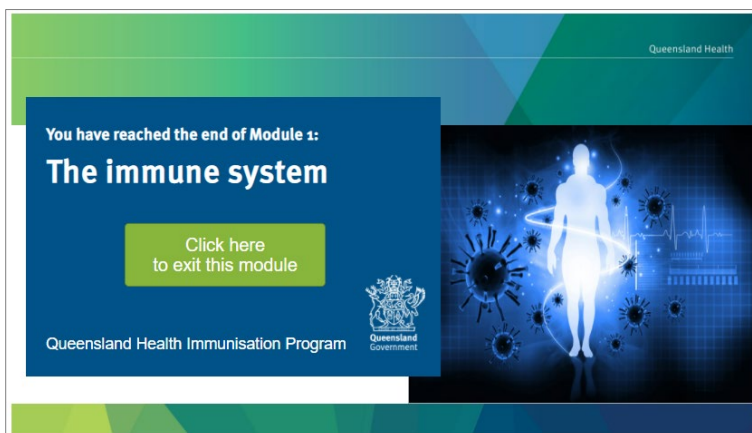

Each elearning module is self-paced and interactive. There is a menu bar across the top that you can use to access navigation, transcripts of spoken audio, the glossary and downloadable resources.




At the end of each module, be sure to click the green button to exit the module. Clicking this triggers your certificate to be generated.



Accessing your certificate


Upon completion of each elearning module, the relevant certificate becomes available to download.
