
This book is from Queensland Health.

The plan has 7 areas.





Inclusive means everyone

• can be part of something



• feels important.

We want people from **diverse groups** to work with us.



Diverse groups might mean

First Nations people



people with disability




• people from different cultures.





Gender identity means who you are as a person.



Gender identity is **not only** about if your body is male or female.



Your gender identity can be

woman



• something else.

You might also have different **pronouns**.





Pronouns are words you want us to say when we talk about you.

For example

he and him





she and her





• they and them.

Who we want to include



Sexuality means who you are attracted to.



We want to support people of any sexuality.



We also want to support **refugees**.

Refugees are people who

• are **not** safe in their home country



and

move to another country to be safe.



We will ask people from diverse groups what they think about our work.



We will listen to what people from diverse groups tell us.



2. We will train our staff

We will make sure our staff know how to work with people with disability.



We will also give people with disability good healthcare.

We will make sure that people in Queensland can get a **health passport** if they want to.



Health passports are a way for people to

keep their health information together



• share their important health information.

3. We will be accessible



Accessible places are easy for everyone to

• go to



• use.



Accessible also means

you can get information in different ways



• everyone can understand the information.



We will make sure people with disability can use our buildings.



We will also make sure our information is in lots of different languages.



We will make sure we have **interpreters** for people with disability.



Interpreters

speak your language



• help you say what is happening to you.

We will help people who use assistive technology.



Assistive technology means things that help people with disability.



For example, a machine that reads what you type out loud.





Respect means we will

• use good manners



listen to you



• **not** hurt you.




We want people with disability to feel safe in **healthcare settings**.

Healthcare settings could mean

a hospital



• a dentist clinic.





Violence is when someone

hurts you



• says they will hurt you or someone else



• makes you feel you are **not** safe.





Research means we will

look for information



 learn more about how we can support people with disability.



We want to make sure we know how many people in Queensland have a disability.



We also want to know about the **experiences** of people with disability in healthcare.

Experiences are things that happen to you.



For example, a bad experience might be going to a hospital that a wheelchair **cannot** enter.

We will work with people with disability.



We will help people with intellectual disability

have healthy mouths




• have healthy teeth.

We want to make it easier for people with disability to use **telehealth**.



Telehealth is when you

• talk to your doctor on a phone or computer





• are **not** in the same room as your doctor.

• a virus like COVID-19




floods
