Summary of changes

The following changes will be implemented in the Queensland Hospital Admitted Patient Data Collection (QHAPDC) for the 2023-2024 data collection period to meet Department of Health, State and National reporting requirements. Applicable changes will be applied to the *private facility file formats* as referenced in the table below.

<p>1. Person-Sex (code) description update</p> <p>Reference file update to <i>Person-sex (code)</i> data item. The description for code 3 will change from 'Other' to 'X' to report the patient's sex. This update is to align with Queensland Health approved data standards.</p> <p>Note: This may require a change to the reference file in electronic systems.</p>	Private File Format – pages 10 and 39
<p>2. AN-SNAP Grouper - Version 5</p> <p>The Independent Hospital and Aged Care Pricing Authority (IHACPA) has developed AN-SNAP Version 5.0 through detailed statistical analysis of public hospital activity and cost data, as well as consultation with jurisdictions, clinical experts and other subacute care stakeholders. AN-SNAP Version 5.0 is a modest refinement of Version 4.0.</p> <p>SSB will be implementing the new certified AN-SNAP Grouper to produce Version 5 SNAP end classes. Version 4 SNAP end classes will continue to be derived for episodes of care separated from 1 July 2023 onwards.</p> <p>Healthcare Purchasing and Funding Branch (HPFB) has advised that the IHACPA are continuing to fund sub and non-acute episodes of care using Version 4 SNAP end classes. HPFB anticipate using Version 5 end cases produced on 2023-24 SNAP episodes for shadow funding costing and funding analysis purposes.</p> <p>Note: This only applies to publicly contracted SNAP patients</p>	N/A
<p>3. QHAPDC Private Facility File Format & PHI(1) FORM - Compliance Notes</p> <p>The <i>QHAPDC Private Facility File Format</i> and the <i>PHI(1) FORM</i> have been updated to include references under the 'Notes' to ensure this documentation includes references to the Private Health Facilities Act 1999 for compliance purposes.</p>	Private File Format – Notes, Page 1
