Queensland Health has 11 Allied Health Rural Generalist Training Positions in rural and remote areas across the state.

These are designated new graduate positions, designed to kick-start your career in rural and remote practice in a supportive and development-focussed role. Positions are available across a range of allied health professions.

### **Development-focussed and supported**

Allied Health Rural Generalist Training Positions are located in a team with an experienced practitioner of the same profession to provide on-site support and development opportunities.

All Allied Health Rural Generalist Training Positions have a development plan, with allocated time (up to 20%) and funding to undertake professional development activities such as clinical placements, workshops and courses, and independent study.

### **Innovative rural generalist services**

Allied Health Rural Generalist Training Positions are involved in innovative service development initiatives designed to improve the health of their communities. Initiatives include telehealth-supported service delivery, expanded scope of practice and other new service models.
