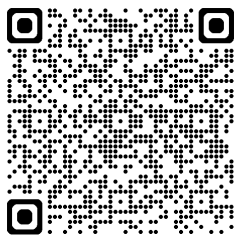
Can I take the syringe driver out of the plastic box?

No. The box helps to prevent damage to the driver (pump)

Contact your care team

- If you require help on using the syringe driver (pump)
- If the syringe driver (pump) is no longer required
- If there are problems with the syringe driver (pump):
 - Battery not working
 - Broken or damaged syringe driver (pump)
 - Tubing is leaking
 - The pump has gotten wet
 - Pump is flashing and alarming
