To the Hon Cameron Dick, Minister for health, following on from our meeting and previous email, I am writing to inform you that the Health Ombudsman has now contacted me in regards to [REDACTED]. I have passed on the information to [REDACTED] the Principle Triage at the Health Ombudsman as well as [REDACTED] phone number, Unfortunately [REDACTED] herself has experienced a medical emergency and was unable to contact you as expected earlier in the week.

In regards to the other children discussed, I have informed the family of both children the correct avenues if they wish to pursue further action, as they are grieving I am allowing them to do this in their own time.

In regards to the 15 yo male with cancer, his medical situation was addressed by Dr [REDACTED] in May 2015, at a meeting you attended at LCCH, this document stated many concerns from parents including their quotes and Dr [REDACTED] also personally read aloud the story of this young man, since then I am not aware of any follow up on any of the individual situations listed. Those incidences were given to you in the hope you saw how serious the problems were at Lady Cilento with the assumption the Qld Govt would intervene and take further steps to ensure the processes and systems that have failed so many parents were fixed.

The Qld Premier stated at the Bundaberg Community Cabinet that the Labor Govt had conducted 2 reviews in regards to LCCH, it is my understanding this is incorrect and only the Commissioning Review was requested under the Labor Government. The response from yourself and Children's Health Qld indicated to the public that these problems had been fixed and there was no patient harm.

As stated on Sunday I am concerned that patient's who have experienced delays in treatment or surgery have passed away, for this reason I hope that the QLD Govt will look into this further and investigate the health and well being of patients whose care has been compromised as a result of a flawed opening and flawed systems at Lady Cilento.
