

# Obstetrics and Gynaecology training preference guide

## RMO Campaign 2023

The [FRANZCOG Training Program](#) offered by the [Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists](#) (RANZCOG) is the only means through which a medical practitioner in Australia can become a specialist obstetrician / gynaecologist. To be selected onto the training program with RANZCOG, applicants must apply directly to the college for an allocation to a Queensland facility.

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued from a training facility, new and continuing applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an application via the RMO Campaign portal. ## RMO Application: Step 10 Preferences

### First Year Trainees

Applicants who have applied to be selected onto the **First Year FRANZCOG Training Program** are advised to select College/Pathway/Network (Determined) as the first preference facility:

What is your first preferred Specialty? \*

What is your first preferred Sub-Specialty? \*


Obstetrics & Gynaecology (AT)

As up to 5 preferences may be recorded as part of the application, it is recommended that applicants utilise a lower preference to indicate which positions they may be interested in if they are not selected to their preferred positions. ## Second or Subsequent Year Trainees

Applicants progressing onto the second or subsequent years of the **FRANZCOG Training Program** are advised to **select their assigned accredited Queensland training facility** as the first preference from the list below:
