RMO application: Step 10 Preferences

To be **considered** for a position on the **Queensland Public Health Medicine Advanced Training Program**, in the main **'Preferences'** section of the online RMO application you **MUST** complete your first preference as follows:

What is your first preferred facility? *

College/Pathway/Network (Determined)

What is your first preferred position? *

Registrar

What is your first preferred Specialty? *

Public Health Medicine

What is your first preferred Sub-Specialty? *

Pub Health (AT)

As up to 5 preferences may be recorded as part of the application, it is recommended that applicants utilise a lower preference to indicate which positions they may be interested in if they are not selected onto the training pathway.
