Certified alternative way (to complying with the Poisons Standard, Part 2) of labelling a package containing a controlled drug, a restricted drug or a poison (labelling exemption)

Health (Drugs and Poisons) Regulation 1996 - section 11

I, Gregory Perry, Director, Healthcare Approvals and Regulation Unit and delegate of the Chief Executive, Queensland Health, do hereby certify the following alternative way of labelling a package containing a controlled drug, a restricted drug or a poison:

The Alternative Way

In Queensland, the products in Table 1 labelled as Schedule 4 medicines with the signal words 'Prescription Only Medicine' can be supplied by Alphapharm Pty Ltd as Schedule 3 (Pharmacist Only Medicine) products, provided all other aspects of the labelling other than the incorrect signal headings are compliant with the Poisons Standard.

Table 1: Product to which label exemption applies

Aust R 124086	SUMATRIPTAN IPTAM® packs of two tablets each containing 50 mg of sumatriptan

Conditions of certification

1. Retail supply is to be from pharmacies only and the incorrectly labelled products will need to be stored in pharmacies as Schedule 4 products.
2. Each supply to a consumer must include the Consumer Medicine Information approved by the Commonwealth Therapeutic Goods Administration for the medicine.
3. This certification is effective from date of signature.
4. This certification expires on 01 February 2022 or until existing stock of Schedule 4 labelled product is exhausted, whichever is the earlier.
