### Course 3 | Vaccine preparation and administration

This online course provides a comprehensive overview of the complex and ever-changing topic of immunisation for those who receipt, administer, or manage vaccines in Queensland.

In this course you will learn about pre-vaccination screening, how to prepare and administer vaccines, and how to care for patients post vaccination. The course also contains information to equip you with the knowledge to recognise and respond to adverse events post vaccination and how to record and report vaccinations to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).
