



### Guide to completing this application

- This application form is to be used by landholders to apply for an approval to **buy, possess, apply and dispose restricted S7 (RS7) poisons** under the ***Medicines and Poisons Act 2019 (MPA)*** and the ***Medicines and Poisons (Poisons and Prohibited Substances) Regulation 2021 (Poisons Regulation)***. Information for rural landholders seeking to control invasive animals using RS7 poison is available at the Department of Health's website.
- Please print clearly and answer all questions in full. You will be contacted if information is incomplete or additional information is required. This may delay the application process.
- This application does not need to be completed by landholders:
  - participating in a local government coordinated 1080 baiting program, or seeking to obtain Low-risk fluoroacetic acid baits (LRFAB) containing 0.5 g/Kg or less fluoroacetic acid, from an authorised officer under the *Biosecurity Act 2014* or the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*
  - wanting to buy manufactured (shelf-stable) LRFABs and who are the holders of a current General approval – Manufactured low-risk fluoroacetic acid baits
- The documents listed below are required to be submitted with this application form. To avoid unnecessary delays, ensure you provide all the required documents together:
  - For individuals/partnership, a verified copy of proof of identification for each individual e.g. drivers' licence, birth certificate, passport,
  - For a company, a verified copy of a current company extract from the Australian Securities & Investments Commission (ASIC),
  - Verified copy of a recent local government rates notice or lease notice that identifies the property description (lot/plan number) of all land parcels to be baited, as proof of ownership/occupancy.
  - If you are not the property owner, you will need a consent letter from the owner stating that they give permission for you to lay poison baits on their property.
  - Verified copies of certificates of attainment for competencies specified in Section 8
  - A scaled map showing details and features related to your intended baiting activities, see Section 10
- Photocopied documents including evidence of identity must bear the signature, name and occupation of an authorised identifier (verified copy) i.e. signed by health or legal professionals, Public Health Unit officers, government representatives, public servants, bank officers.
- The person signing on behalf of an entity must be an Executive Officer or a person authorised to sign on behalf of the entity.
- Applications and attachments will be provided to the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries and the local government your properties are in, for advice and comments on your application.
- If the space provided in any section is insufficient, please attach additional documents with the required information, indicating clearly which section of the form it applies to.
- The Department may carry out inquiries in relation to your application as considered necessary.

The map must be to an appropriate scale to enable the distance between bait locations and other features to be determined. A minimum distance of 2 kilometres outside the property boundaries is required to be shown to identify sensitive features including neighbours’ dwellings and townships. Please note that you may be asked to resubmit maps that are not clear or are not to an appropriate scale, which may delay the application process.

Your map must include a legend that details the location of important features as indicated below:

Example legend symbols: X - entrances/exits; ■ - dwellings; ▨ - proposed baiting locations/areas.

~ - water courses (blue); || - roads (red); ◇ - locations of poison warning signs; ○ - stock routes
