The Society invites the Minister, the Honourable Cameron Dick, to be guest speaker at the Society's March 2016 dinner. The preferred dates are Thursday 10 or Thursday 17 March.

The Society is a professional organisation with 400 members drawn from the senior ranks of the medical and legal professional communities. It is a professional interest group directed to the interface between the respective professions.

The Society activities consist of an annual mid-year conference, together with several dinners either side. On the dinner nights we usually have between about 100 and 150 registrants.

Recent past speakers have included Dr Leigh Atkinson, Neurosurgeon. The speaker at the December dinner will be Father Frank Brennan, Jesuit Priest and Lawyer.

The Minister is invited to speak on the topic of his choice. There will be no questions from the audience unless the Minister requests that.

The Minister's spouse would be welcome to attend. In addition, if the Minister prefers to have an advisor, or like person attend with him, then that would be quite in order.

I know the Minister. In separate private communication with him I have raised the prospect of him so speaking. The point of this email is to make an official request that he attend.

Obviously the Society would like to make arrangements as soon as possible in respect of the dinner. Certainly we would need to know, at latest, by the end of the first week in December whether the Minister is available.
