



Enhanced Search

Smart Referrals has been designed to make it easy for GPs to provide essential referral information by providing intuitive searching. This is achieved through leveraging SnoMed terms as well as Specialty Alternate Names to improve searchability for the appropriate Clinical Prioritisation Criteria (CPC) and/or Specialty within the referral template.

Condition and Specialty

GPs are encouraged to search for a condition in the first instance, as this will offer the appropriate CPC template and articulate minimum referral criteria relevant for the patients' presentation.

NOTE: CPC conditions can be differentiated by their Specialty and life stage i.e. adult vs. paediatric.

SnoMed to CPC Conditions

- SnoMed terms are mapped to CPC conditions and will provide the GP all relevant results:

- Alternate Names are applied to Specialties (Clinical Disciplines) to assist with other common terminology searches:

Where a condition is not available, we request the specialty search be undertaken, where a generic template is provided for the GP to provide all relevant clinical information.

IMPORTANT: Reporting will be available to the Smart Referrals Support Team to understand the search terms GPs are undertaking to select the appropriate template.

This information will be leveraged to guide future SnoMed term mapping and/or Alternate Name mapping.
