(f) Excludes unqualified newborns, posthumous organ procurement, and boarders.

(g) The data source for pathology occasions of service changed from 1 July 2000 and resulted in a larger number of services being reported.

(h) Includes Dental Hospitals and dental occasions of service up to and including financial year 2007/2008. From 2008/2009 Dental are no longer reported.
