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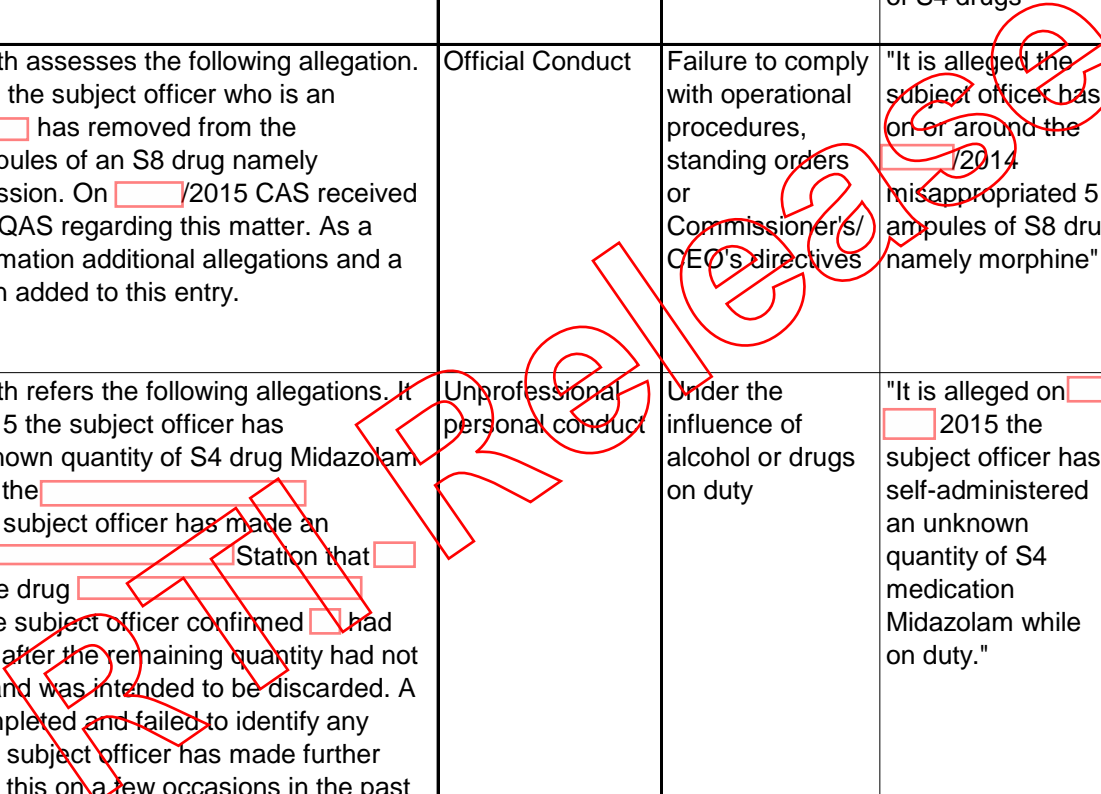

It is alleged between [redacted] and [redacted] 2016, the subject officer has misappropriated 5 ampoules of Morphine from the drug safe of [redacted] Ambulance Station. The bottom Morphine box was found to have a broken tamper proof seal with the contents emptied. This matter has been referred to QPS for investigation. QP [redacted] refers. [redacted]</p> <p>[redacted]. All ampoules appear to have been removed from the bottom box with tamper proof seal broken and stuck back down, similar to the alleged theft at [redacted]. The audit also identified the subject officer has failed to follow the appropriate Drug Management process with numerous discrepancies of Morphine administration occurring between [redacted] [redacted] 2016. This matter has been referred to QPS for investigation and linked to the [redacted] Occurrence.
