  - 4. Dynamic risk assessment and decision making
  - 5. Safer de-escalation
  - 6. Personal safety and post incident
- Patient Handling Fundamentals** (Annual requirement, approx. 45 mins). *Those who do not assist in manually transferring patients are exempt.*
- First Response Evacuation Instructions and Emergency Colour Codes** (Annual requirement, approx. 30 mins)
- Conduct and Ethics** (Annual requirement, approx. 20 mins)
- Fraud Awareness** (Annual requirement, approx. 15 mins)
- Infection Prevention Control** (Annual requirement, approx. 15 mins)
