<p><b>1. AR-DRG Version 10.0 Grouper</b> AR-DRG Version 10.0 Grouper is to be used for allocating DRGs. Public Hospitals are to continue reporting Version 9.0 DRGs to align with the Queensland Department of Health's Activity Based Funding (ABF) Model for admitted patient separations for 2019-2020.</p>	17
<p><b>2. ICD-10-AM/ACHI 11th Edition</b> ICD-10-AM/ACHI 11th Edition will be used for diagnostic coding, replacing ICD-10-AM/ACHI 10th Edition morbidity coding for episodes of care with a separation date from 1 July 2019 inclusive.</p>	33, 69
<p><b>3. Telehealth Provider Type</b> The current 2-digit Telehealth Provider Type code set is to be superseded by a more comprehensive 8-digit code set for separations from 1 July 2019 inclusive.</p> <p><i>A corresponding HBCIS enhancement in the June 2019 release will contain an update to the Provider Type field.</i></p>	56, 83
<p><b>4. Account Class codes for NIS funded episodes</b> The Account Class domain has been updated with additional codes to identify episodes funded by the National Injury Insurance Scheme (NIIS) for separations from 1 July 2019 inclusive.</p>	Appendix I
