



Rural Isolated Practice Registered Nurse (RIPRN) course

This course has been developed for registered nurses wishing to expand their knowledge and skills to meet the legislative requirements to practice as a RIPRN. This course will equip you with the necessary knowledge and skills to provide healthcare within the unique challenges of the rural and remote context, while fulfilling your legal, professional, and ethical obligations. The course meets the educational and legislative requirements authorising Registered Nurses to manage patients (including the use of certain medicines) across the lifespan utilising the Health Management Protocols (HMPs) and Clinical Care Guidelines (CCGs) within the Primary Clinical Care Manual (PCCM).

This course has a current articulation agreement with UniSQ, whereby graduates can obtain credit for 4 subjects in their Graduate Diploma of Nursing (Rural & Remote specialisation).

Careers and outcomes

You will be awarded with a Certificate of Completion and 450 Continuing Professional Development (CPD) hours upon successful completion of the course.

This course meets the educational and legislative requirements to apply to practice as a RIPRN in approved rural and remote areas of Queensland, Victoria, RFDS (Qld Section), and the Australian Defence Force.
