



Don't touch me!

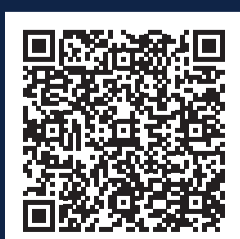
**Australian bat lyssavirus
is fatal to humans.**

It is spread from bats to humans when the saliva or brain tissue of an infected bat enters the human body, normally through a scratch or bite.

The best protection is to never touch bats.

Only trained and vaccinated people should ever touch bats.
