Outpatients Department. Referral should include complete patient / family history relevant to the patient's condition or complaint.

All investigation results are to accompany the patient referral when sent to UROLOGY outpatients department. Tests results should be dated within three (3) months of referral date. Patients are to bring films to appointment.

Recurrent UTIs	All previous MSU for M/C/S, FBE, ELFTs
	Plain X-Ray KUB
	Renal Tract Ultrasound including Residual Urine Measure
Urinary Calculus	MSU for M/C/S, FBE, U&E
	E/LFTs
	CT KUB + AXR
Scrotal conditions (If solid lesion – mark referral as URGENT)	MSU for M/C/S
	Ultrasound of Scrotal Contents
	Chest X-Ray, HCG, a-FP, E/LFT if solid testicular mass
Solid Renal Mass on Ultrasound	MSU for M/C/S
	E/LFTs + FBC Urine Cytology x 1
	CXR PA
	CT IVP
Loin Pain / Stone Disease	MSU for M/C/S
	E/LFTs + FBC + ESR
	CT KUB + AXR
