- An episode of care for an admitted patient may be a total hospital stay or a portion of a stay that begins or ends in a change of care type.
- COVID-19 defined using ICD-10-AM and includes the following codes:
 - U07.1 Coronavirus disease 2019 [COVID-19], virus identified [including subcodes]
 - U07.2 Coronavirus disease 2019 [COVID-19], virus not identified
 Descriptions above are as per ICD-10-AM Edition 12, implemented from 01 Jul 2022. Prior to Jul 2022, descriptions applicable to ICD-10-AM Edition 11 were "Emergency use of U07.1/U07.2".
- Includes onset type 'Condition arose during the episode of care'. This is defined as a condition which arose during the current episode of care and would not have been present or suspected on admission.
- Restricted to episodes that end between 01 January 2022 and 30 June 2023, in public or private acute hospitals.
