Minor and machinery in nature	The Health Practitioner Regulation National Law and Other Legislation Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2023 postpones commencement of the uncommenced provisions of the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2022. Commencement is postponed until up to 21 October 2024. The postponement will allow more time for legislation to be put in place in other States and Territories to enable national consistency in commencement of the provisions. The proposal is machinery in nature, to postpone the uncommenced provisions of the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2022, and does not result in a substantive change to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government or the community. As such, the Department has identified that no further regulatory impact analysis is required under the Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy.
