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REGION OVERVIEW

The Brisbane (C) - South Region comprises the 84 statistical local areas of Acacia Ridge, Algester, Annerley, Archerfield, Balmoral, Belmont-Mackenzie, Bulimba, Burbank, Calamvale, Camp Hill, Cannon Hill, Carina, Carina Heights, Carindale, Chandler-Capalaba West, Chelmer, Coopers Plains, Coorparoo, Corinda, Darra-Sumner, Doolandella-Forest Lake, Durack, Dutton Park, East Brisbane, Eight Mile Plains, Ellen Grove, Fairfield, Graceville, Greenslopes, Gumdale-Ransome, Hawthorne, Hemmant-Lytton, Highgate Hill, Holland Park, Holland Park West, Inala, Jamboree Heights, Jindalee, Kangaroo Point, Kuraby, Lota, MacGregor, Manly, Manly West, Mansfield, Middle Park, Moorooka, Morningside, Mount Gravatt, Mount Gravatt East, Mount Ommaney, Murarrie, Nathan, Norman Park, Oxley, Pallara-Heathwood-Larapinta, Parkinson-Drewvale, Richlands, Riverhills, Robertson, Rochedale, Rocklea, Runcorn, Salisbury, Seventeen Mile Rocks, Sherwood, South Brisbane, Stretton - Karawatha, Sunnybank, Sunnybank Hills, Tarragindi, Tingalpa, Upper Mount Gravatt, Wacol, Wakerley, West End (Brisbane), Westlake, Willawong, Wishart, Woolloongabba, Wynnum, Wynnum West, Yeerongpilly and Yeronga. It has a total area of 478.3 km², or 0.0 per cent of the total area of the state. The region has an average daily temperature range of 14.9 °C to 25.8 °C and on average Brisbane (C) - South Region receives approximately 1,101 mm of rainfall each year.

Demography

As at 30 June 2010, the estimated resident population of Brisbane (C) - South Region was 576,017 persons, or 12.8 per cent of the state's population.

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 7,773 persons in Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated they were of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander origin, or 1.5 per cent of the total population.

At the time of the 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, 46.2 per cent of persons were living (usually residing) at a different address five years earlier.

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 27.0 per cent of persons in Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated they were born overseas.

In Brisbane (C) - South Region, 9.6 per cent of the 2006 usual resident population were in the most disadvantaged quintile and 32.8 per cent of the population of Brisbane (C) - South Region were in the least disadvantaged quintile.

Society

In 2009, 65.6 per cent of students attending a school in Brisbane (C) - South Region attended a government school and 34.4 per cent attended a non-government school.

At the time of the 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 55.4 per cent of persons aged 15 years and over with a post-school qualification.

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 3.6 per cent of persons in need of assistance with a profound or severe disability in Brisbane (C) - South Region.

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 17.8 per cent of persons aged 15 years and over who were volunteers in the Brisbane (C) - South Region.

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 153,219 persons aged 15 years and over in the Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated their gross individual weekly income was less than \$400 (36.9 per cent of all persons aged 15 years and over).

As at 30 June 2009 in Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 97 aged-care service providers, with a total of 5,443 places in operation.

Economic Performance

The smoothed unemployment rate for Brisbane (C) - South Region in the December quarter 2010 was 5.2 per cent.

At the time of the 2006 Census, Health Care and Social Assistance was the largest industry of employment for Brisbane (C) - South Region usual residents, with 11.1 per cent of the region's employed labour force.

Industry and Development

In the 12 months ending 31 March 2011, there were 3,774 dwelling units in new residential buildings approved in

Brisbane (C) - South Region, which represented a total of \$974.9 million.

The total value of agricultural production in the Brisbane (C) - South Region in 2005–06 was \$25.3 million, 0.3 per cent of the total value of agricultural production in Queensland.

In 2008–09, there were 51,758 businesses in Brisbane (C) - South Region, 12.3 per cent of all Queensland businesses.

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 68.2 per cent of all occupied private dwellings in the region with an internet connection.

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

As at 30 June 2010, the estimated resident population of Brisbane (C) - South Region was 576,017 persons, 12.8 per cent of the state's population. The population of Brisbane (C) - South Region increased by 8,337 persons between 30 June 2009 and 2010 (see following table). This was a 9.4 per cent share of the state's population growth over this period. The region recorded a population growth rate of 1.5 per cent between 30 June 2009 and 2010 (Queensland, 2.0 per cent).

Within the region, the largest increase in population occurred in Wakerley Statistical Local Area (SLA), up by 505 persons in the year to 30 June 2010, accounting for 6.1 per cent of all growth in Brisbane (C) - South Region. The fastest growing statistical local area between 2009 and 2010 was Richlands SLA (17.7 per cent), followed by Pallara-Heathwood-Larapinta SLA (15.7 per cent) and Wakerley SLA (7.5 per cent).

POPULATION BY AGE

In Brisbane (C) - South Region as at 30 June 2009, 18.8 per cent of persons were aged 0 to 14 years, 70.1 per cent were aged 15 to 64 years and 11.1 per cent were aged 65 years and over (see following table).

Wakerley Statistical Local Area (SLA) recorded the highest proportion of children aged 0 to 14 years (27.0 per cent) in Brisbane (C) - South Region, while Kangaroo Point SLA recorded the lowest proportion (5.2 per cent). For the working-age population aged 15 to 64 years, South Brisbane SLA had the largest proportion (84.3 per cent) and Durack and Rochedale SLA recorded the lowest (61.0 per cent). Rochedale SLA had the highest proportion of persons aged 65 years and over (21.0 per cent) and Parkinson-Drewvale SLA recorded the lowest (5.5 per cent).

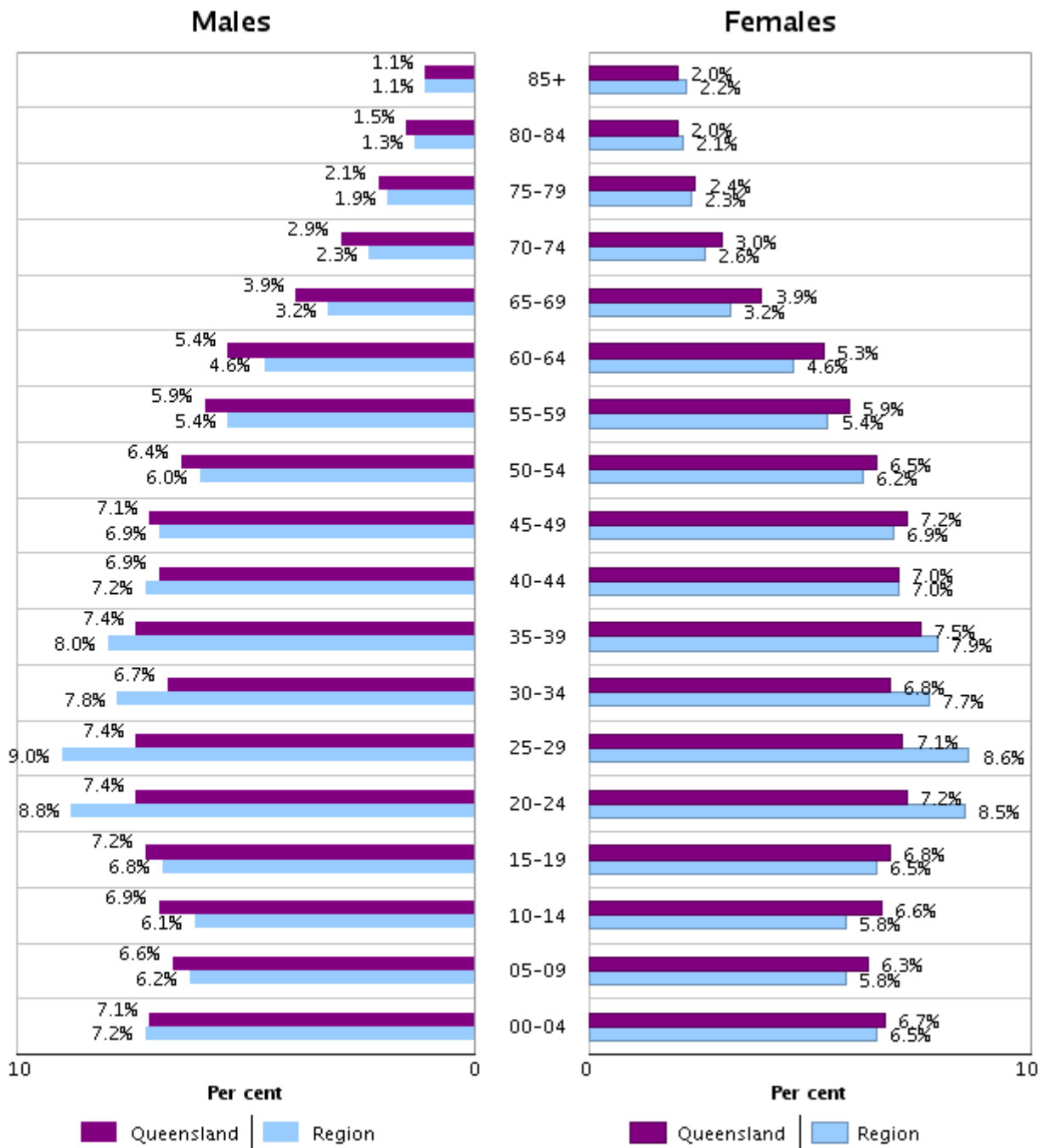

INDIGENOUS POPULATION

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 7,773 persons in Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated they were of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander origin. These persons made up 1.5 per cent of the total population (compared with 3.3 per cent in Queensland). Inala Statistical Local Area (SLA) contained the largest number of Indigenous persons (960 persons) followed by Wacol SLA (415 persons).

Of the 7,773 persons usually resident in Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated they were of Indigenous origin, 6,507 persons stated they were of Aboriginal origin, 734 persons stated they were of Torres Strait Islander origin, and 532 persons stated they were of both Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander origin.

MIGRATION 1 YEAR AGO

At the time of the 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, 19.3 per cent or 97,660 persons were living (usually residing) at a different address one year earlier. In Queensland, 19.7 per cent of persons lived at a different address one year earlier. In Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 380,307 persons who were living at the same address one year earlier.

Of the Statistical Local Areas (SLA) in Brisbane (C) - South Region, Pallara-Heathwood-Larapinta SLA had the highest percentage of people at a different address compared with one year earlier (45.4 per cent), and Chandler-Capalaba West SLA had the lowest percentage (8.1 per cent). The number of people who were living overseas one year earlier was highest in Kangaroo Point SLA (538 persons), followed by Eight Mile Plains SLA (465 persons).

At the time of the 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, 46.2 per cent or 221,671 persons were living (usually residing) at a different address five years earlier. In Queensland, 47.6 per cent of persons lived at a different address five years earlier. In Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 225,894 persons who were living at the same address five years earlier.

Of the Statistical Local Areas (SLA) in the Brisbane (C) - South Region, Wakerley SLA had the highest percentage of people at a different address compared with five years earlier (75.4 per cent), and Wacol SLA had the lowest percentage (19.6 per cent). The number of people who were living overseas five years earlier was highest in Runcorn SLA (1,553 persons), followed by Sunnybank Hills SLA (1,423 persons).

COUNTRY OF BIRTH

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 138,558 persons in Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated they were born overseas (27.0 per cent of the total population) and 344,202 persons who stated they were Australian-born (67.0 per cent of the total population). In Queensland, 17.9 per cent of the Queensland population were born overseas and 75.2 per cent were Australian-born.

Sunnybank Hills Statistical Local Area (SLA) contained the largest number of overseas-born persons in the region (6,576), followed by Doolandella-Forest Lake SLA (5,465).

PROFICIENCY IN SPOKEN ENGLISH

At the time of 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 71,566 persons born overseas who stated that they spoke a language other than English at home (51.7 per cent of the overseas-born population). In Queensland, 31.3 per cent of the overseas-born population spoke a language other than English at home.

Of the overseas-born persons in the region who stated that they spoke a language other than English, 15,148 persons stated that they spoke English not well or not at all. This was 10.9 per cent of the overseas-born population of Brisbane (C) - South Region, compared with 5.1 per cent in Queensland.

Inala Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest number of overseas-born persons who spoke English not well or not at all in the region (1,268 persons), followed by Sunnybank Hills SLA (1,045 persons).

FAMILY COMPOSITION

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 134,192 families in Brisbane (C) - South Region (13.0 per cent of all Queensland families). Couple family with children was the dominant family type in the region (60,830 families).

In Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 21,483 one-parent families, accounting for 16.0 per cent of all families in the region (compared with 15.9 per cent in Queensland).

Doolandella-Forest Lake Statistical Local Area (SLA) contained the largest number of families in the region (4,877 families), followed by Sunnybank Hills SLA (4,378 families). Wacol SLA recorded the highest proportion of one-parent families (34.3 per cent), followed by Inala SLA (34.2 per cent).

SOCIO-ECONOMIC INDEX OF DISADVANTAGE

Socio-Economic Indexes for Areas (SEIFA) is a summary measure of the social and economic conditions of geographic areas across Australia. SEIFA comprises a number of indexes, which are generated at the time of the ABS Census of Population and Housing. In 2006, a Socio-Economic Index of Disadvantage was produced, ranking geographical regions to reflect disadvantage of social and economic conditions. The index focuses on low-income earners, relatively lower education attainment, high unemployment and dwellings without motor vehicles. Low index values represent areas of most disadvantage and high values represent areas of least disadvantage.

The following table shows the percentage of the population in each quintile (one-fifth or 20 per cent of the population) according to the Socio-Economic Index of Disadvantage. Quintile 1 represents the most disadvantaged group of persons, while quintile 5 represents the least disadvantaged group of persons.

By definition, Queensland has 20 per cent of the population in each quintile. In comparison, 9.6 per cent of the population of Brisbane (C) - South Region were in the most disadvantaged quintile. Compared with the 20 per cent average across Queensland, 32.8 per cent of the population of Brisbane (C) - South Region were in the least disadvantaged quintile.

SCHOOL STUDENTS

In 2009, there were 89,492 school students attending in the Brisbane (C) - South Region (see following table). The Statistical Local Area (SLA) in the region with the largest number of school students was Doolandella-Forest Lake SLA with 4,933 students. This was followed by South Brisbane SLA (4,635 students).

For students attending a school in the region, 65.6 per cent attended a government school and 34.4 per cent attended a non-government school. The corresponding percentages for Queensland were 67.5 per cent of school students attended government schools and 32.5 per cent attended non-government schools.

There were 36,998 students attending a government primary school (years 1 to 7) in Brisbane (C) - South Region SLA and 16,807 students attending a non-government primary school. In secondary school (years 8 to 12) there were 21,063 government students and 13,993 non-government students.

HIGHEST LEVEL OF SCHOOLING

At the time of the 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 250,705 persons aged 15 years and over with year 11 or 12 (or equivalent) stated as their highest level of schooling (60.4 per cent of all persons aged 15 years and over). This corresponded with 49.5 per cent in Queensland.

Nathan Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the highest proportion of persons with year 11 or year 12 or equivalent as their highest level of schooling in the region (73.8 per cent), followed by Hawthorne SLA (73.4 per cent).

POST-SCHOOL QUALIFICATION

At the time of the 2006 Census, in Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 230,062 persons aged 15 years and over with a qualification, or 55.4 per cent of the population in this age group. The proportion for Queensland was 50.4 per cent.

In Brisbane (C) - South Region there were 89,088 persons with a bachelor degree or higher, 32,288 persons with an advanced diploma or diploma, and 60,152 persons with a certificate. Of persons aged 15 years and over with a qualification, 38.7 per cent had bachelor degree or higher (26.0 per cent in Queensland), 14.0 per cent had an advanced diploma or diploma (13.1 per cent in Queensland), and 26.1 per cent had a certificate (35.5 per cent in Queensland).

Coorparoo Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest number of persons aged 15 years and over with a qualification in the region (7,273 persons) followed by Sunnybank Hills SLA (6,918 persons).

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING STUDENTS

In 2009 the Brisbane (C) - South Region had a total of 34,220 vocational education and training (VET) students, 12.3 per cent of total VET students in Queensland. This was made up of 24,626 students commencing a VET course and 9,578 students continuing a VET course, 13.0 per cent and 10.9 per cent of commencing and continuing VET students in Queensland respectively.

Doolandella-Forest Lake Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest number of total VET students in the Brisbane (C) - South Region (1,533 students), followed by Inala SLA with 1,230 students.

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE SERVICES

At 30 April 2011, the Brisbane (C) - South Region had a total of 348 early childhood education and care services, 13.0 per cent of Queensland's total early childhood education and care services. The most common early childhood education and care services were long day care services, with 187 services, followed by school aged care services with 98 services.

NEED FOR ASSISTANCE

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 18,598 persons in need of assistance with a profound or severe disability in Brisbane (C) - South Region. This represented 3.6 per cent of the total persons in the region. In comparison, Queensland had 154,707 persons in need of assistance or 4.0 per cent of the total population. VOLUNTEERS

INDIVIDUAL WEEKLY INCOME

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 153,219 persons aged 15 years and over in the Brisbane (C) - South Region who stated their gross individual weekly income was less than \$400 (36.9 per cent of all persons aged 15 years and over). This was lower than the 39.7 per cent recorded in Queensland.

PERSONAL INCOME

During 2007–08 the average annual personal income in Brisbane (C) - South Region was \$45,697. This was higher than the average annual personal income for Queensland (\$41,911). The average wage and salary income in Brisbane (C) - South Region was \$44,930, the average annual unincorporated business income was \$22,050 and the average investment income was \$7,047.

Within the Brisbane (C) - South Region, Bulimba Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the highest average annual personal income (\$64,276), followed by Hawthorne (SLA) (\$64,266).

AGED-CARE SERVICES

As at 30 June 2009 in Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 97 aged-care service providers, with a total of 5,443 places in operation. During 2008–09, the aged-care service providers in Brisbane (C) - South Region received \$168.2 million in Australian government recurrent funding, 13.4 per cent of total funding received in Queensland (\$1,259.9 million).

Wynnum West Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest number of aged-care service places with 376, followed by Corinda with 367.

EMERGENCY SERVICES, SCHOOLS AND HOSPITALS

As at 30 June 2010, in Brisbane (C) - South Region there were 16 police stations, 9 ambulance stations, 10 fire stations, 169 schools and 19 hospitals. Brisbane (C) - South Region contained 4.7 per cent of Queensland's police stations, 3.4 per cent of Queensland's ambulance stations, 4.1 per cent of Queensland's fire stations, 9.7 per cent of Queensland's schools and 7.0 per cent of Queensland's hospitals.

Sunnybank, Doolandella-Forest Lake and Coorparoo Statistical Local Area had the most schools in the region with a total of 6.

UNEMPLOYMENT AND LABOUR FORCE

The number of unemployed persons aged 15 years and over (based on a smoothed series) in Brisbane (C) - South Region in December quarter 2010 was 17,503 persons. This represented an unemployment rate of 5.2 per cent, compared with Queensland, which had a smoothed unemployment rate of 5.5 per cent.

Burbank Statistical Local Area (SLA) recorded the lowest smoothed unemployment rate in the region (1.6 per cent) and Richlands SLA recorded the highest smoothed unemployment rate (19.0 per cent).

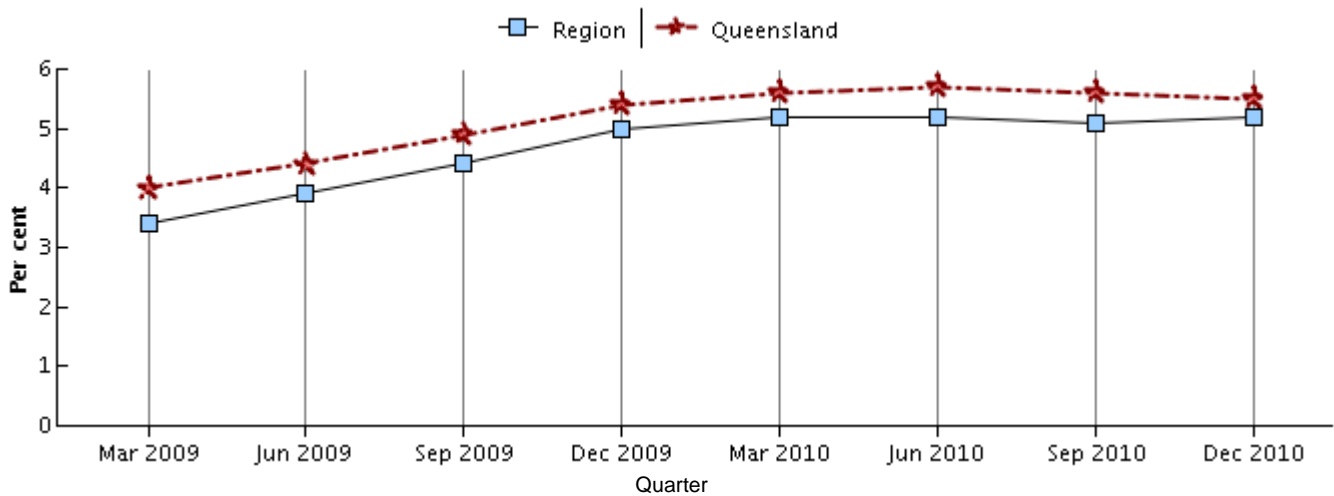

The unemployment rate in Brisbane (C) - South Region for the December quarter 2010 was 5.2 per cent, compared with 5.5 per cent in Queensland. EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY

At the time of the 2006 Census, Health Care and Social Assistance was the largest industry of employment for Brisbane (C) - South Region usual residents, with 28,433 persons or 11.1 per cent of the region's employed labour force. Other industries with relatively large numbers of employed persons included Retail Trade (27,507 persons or 10.7 per cent) and Manufacturing (26,393 persons or 10.3 per cent).

The highest specialisation ratios in the region occurred in the industries of Professional, Scientific and Technical Services (1.49), Financial and Insurance Services (1.47) and Wholesale Trade (1.23).

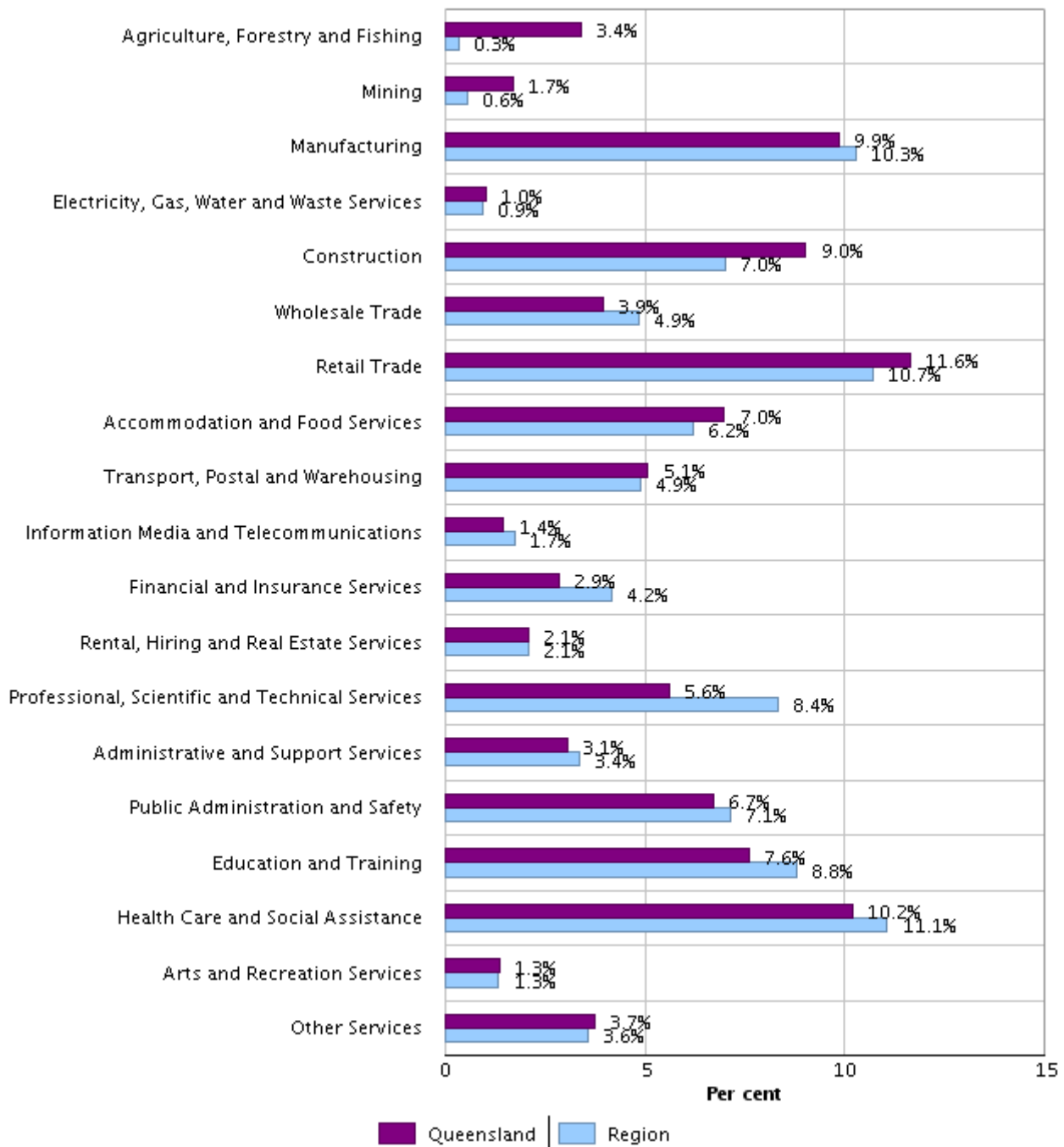

EMPLOYMENT BY OCCUPATION

At the time of the 2006 Census, Professionals were the largest occupation group of employment of Brisbane (C) - South Region usual residents, with 62,187 persons or 24.2 per cent of the region's employed labour force. Other occupation groups with relatively large numbers of employed persons included Clerical & administrative workers (43,162 persons or 16.8 per cent) and Technicians & trades workers (32,467 persons or 12.7 per cent).

The highest specialisation ratios in the region occurred in the occupation groups of Professionals (1.41) and Clerical & administrative workers (1.14).

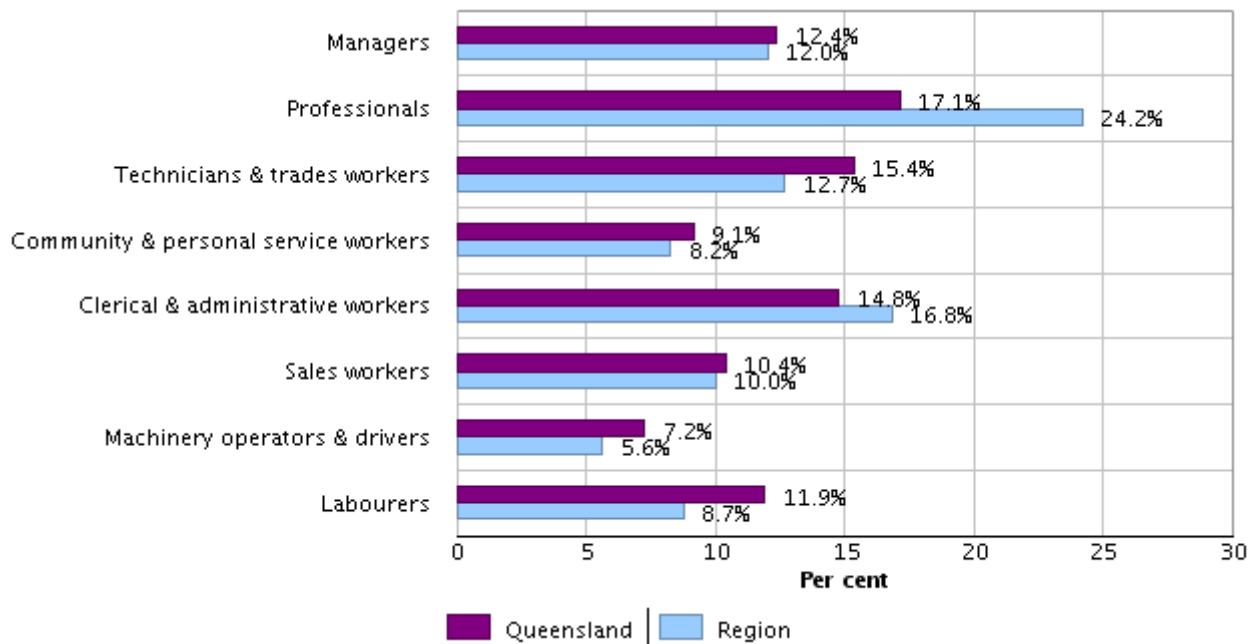

BUILDING APPROVALS

In the 12 months ending 31 March 2011, there were 3,774 dwelling units in new residential buildings approved in Brisbane (C) - South Region. These approvals were valued at \$974.9 million and accounted for 13.9 per cent of the total value of Queensland's new residential approvals over the period. Within the region, South Brisbane Statistical Local Area (SLA) and Richlands SLA recorded the largest values of new residential building approvals (\$84.7 million and \$52.8 million respectively).

The total value of non-residential building approvals in Brisbane (C) - South Region in the 12 months ending 31 March 2011 was \$2,293.3 million, or 34.3 per cent of the value of these approvals in the state. The largest values of non-residential approvals were recorded in South Brisbane SLA (\$1,129.1 million) and Carindale SLA (\$241.2 million).

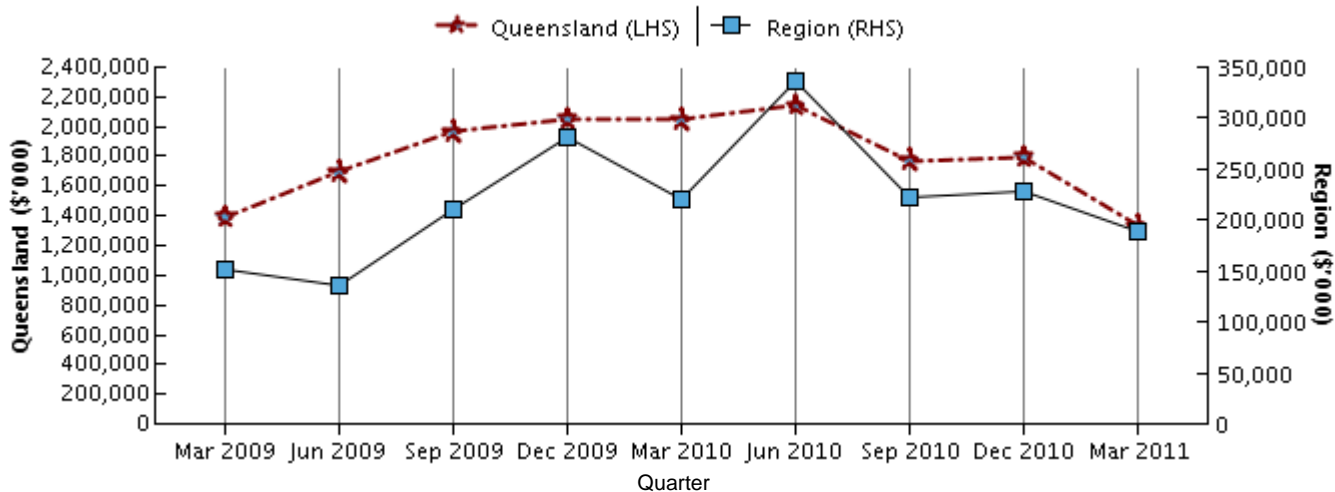

Figure 6 Value of residential building approvals (a), Brisbane (C) - South Region and Queensland, March quarter 2009 to March quarter 2011



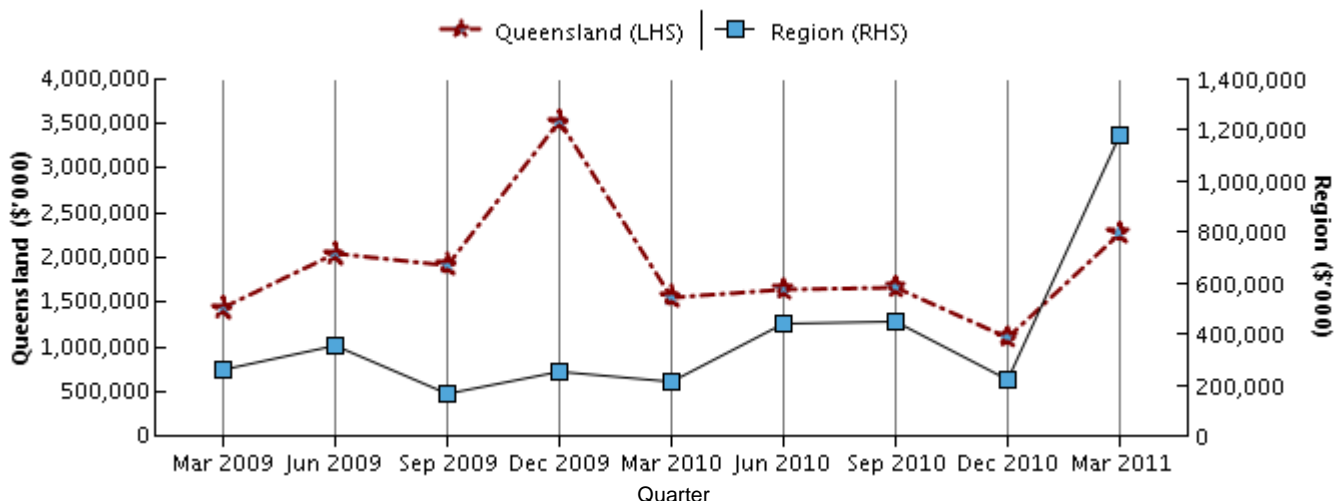

DWELLINGS BY DWELLING STRUCTURE

At the time of the 2006 Census there were 185,765 occupied private dwellings in Brisbane (C) - South Region, representing 13.3 per cent of Queensland's total occupied private dwellings. Of these dwellings, 143,929 were separate houses, 16,274 were semi-detached and 23,882 were apartments. In Brisbane (C) - South Region, separate houses represented 77.5 per cent of total occupied private dwellings, compared with 79.5 per cent for Queensland.

Within Brisbane (C) - South Region, Gumdale-Ransome, Stretton - Karawatha and Jindalee Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the highest percentage of separate houses (100.0 per cent), followed by Chandler-Capalaba West SLA (99.3 per cent).

DWELLINGS BY TENURE TYPE

At the time of the 2006 Census there were 185,771 occupied private dwellings in Brisbane (C) - South Region, representing 13.3 per cent of Queensland's total occupied private dwellings. Of these dwellings, 55,745 were fully owned (30.0 per cent of the total), 62,132 were being purchased (33.4 per cent of the total) and 61,685 were being rented (33.2 per cent of the total).

Within Brisbane (C) - South Region, Rochedale Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the greatest percentage of fully owned private dwellings (59.7 per cent), followed by Burbank SLA (55.1 per cent). The region with the highest percentage of dwellings being rented was Kangaroo Point SLA (59.4 per cent)

VALUE OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION

The total value of agricultural production in the Brisbane (C) - South Region in 2005–06 was \$25.3 million, 0.3 per cent of the total value of agricultural production in Queensland. Crops accounted for \$23.4 million or 92.5 per cent of the regions total value of agricultural production, livestock slaughterings accounted for \$0.3 million (1.4 per cent) and livestock products were valued at \$1.5 million (6.1 per cent of the total).

The region produced 0.6 per cent of the total value of crops in Queensland, and 0.0 per cent and 0.4 per cent of the total value of Queensland livestock slaughterings and livestock products respectively.

Rochedale Statistical Local Area (SLA) recorded the largest value of agricultural production in the region (\$8.6 million). Rochedale SLA recorded the largest value of crops (\$7.5 million) and Rochedale SLA recorded the largest value of livestock slaughterings (\$0.1 million).

BUSINESS COUNTS BY EMPLOYMENT SIZE

In 2008–09, there were 51,758 businesses in Brisbane (C) - South Region, 12.3 per cent of all Queensland businesses. Of these businesses, 49,072 were small businesses (94.8 per cent of the total, compared with 95.2 per cent in Queensland), 2,359 were medium businesses and 327 were large businesses.

The Brisbane (C) - South Region contained 12.3 per cent of all small businesses in Queensland, 13.9 per cent of all medium businesses and 11.3 per cent of all large businesses.

Coorparoo Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest number of businesses in the region (1,493), followed by Eight Mile Plains SLA with a total of 1,423 businesses. Highgate Hill SLA had the largest proportion of small businesses (100.0 per cent).

In 2008–09, there were 51,774 businesses in Brisbane (C) - South Region, 12.3 per cent of all Queensland businesses. Of these the region contained 24,106 businesses with a turnover under \$100,000 and 21,530 businesses with a turnover between \$100,000 and \$1 million. There were 6,138 businesses with a turnover of \$1 million or more (11.9 per cent compared with 10.8 per cent for Queensland).

Brisbane (C) - South Region contained 12.6 per cent of all businesses in Queensland with a turnover less than \$100,000 and 13.5 per cent of all businesses with a turnover of \$1 million or more.

Coorparoo Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest number of businesses in the region (1,493), followed by Eight Mile Plains SLA with a total of 1,423 businesses. Archerfield SLA had the largest proportion of businesses with a turnover of \$1 million or more (41.3 per cent).

BUSINESS COUNTS BY INDUSTRY

In 2008–09, the Construction industry had the largest number of businesses for Brisbane (C) - South Region, with 7,996 businesses or 15.4 per cent of the region's total number of businesses. Other industries with relatively large numbers of business counts included Professional, Scientific and Technical Services (6,915 businesses or 13.4 per cent) and Rental, Hiring and Real Estate Services (6,568 businesses or 12.7 per cent).

The highest specialisation ratios in the region occurred in the industries of Health Care and Social Assistance (5.26), Education and Training (3.61) and Other Services (3.44).

INTERNET CONNECTION

At the time of the 2006 Census there were 126,679 occupied private dwellings in Brisbane (C) - South Region with an internet connection. These dwellings represented 68.2 per cent of all occupied private dwellings in the region (compared with 62.8 for Queensland). Of the 126,679 internet connections in the Brisbane (C) - South Region, there were 89,854 broadband connections and 35,745 dial-up connections. The Brisbane (C) - South Region made up 14.5 per cent of the total internet connections in Queensland.

Westlake Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the highest proportion of occupied private dwellings with internet connections in the region (89.0 per cent) followed by Wakerley SLA (85.1 per cent). Sunnybank Hills SLA had the largest number of dwellings with broadband connections in the region (3,005) followed by Coorparoo SLA (2,839). The highest number of dwellings with no internet connection was in Inala SLA (2,539).

NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES PER DWELLING

At the time of the 2006 Census, there were 17,951 occupied private dwellings in Brisbane (C) - South Region with no motor vehicles. These dwellings accounted for 9.7 per cent of all occupied private dwellings in the region (compared with 7.9 per cent for Queensland).

Dutton Park Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest percentage of occupied private dwellings with no motor vehicles in the region (25.3 per cent), followed by West End (Brisbane) SLA (24.8 per cent). PROTECTED AREAS - PARK AND FOREST ESTATE

The total park and forest estate in terms of National Park, State Forest, Timber Reserve and Forest Reserve in Brisbane (C) - South Region as of 2010 was 1.4 square kilometres, 0.0 per cent of the total protected area in Queensland. National Parks were the major component for the Brisbane (C) - South Region as of 2010, accounting for 100.0 per cent of the total protected area within the region.

Hemmant-Lytton Statistical Local Area (SLA) had the largest total protected area in terms of National Park, State Forest, Timber Reserve and Forest Reserve in the region (0.9 square kilometres), followed by Nathan SLA with 0.3 square kilometres.
