

Dermatology training preference guide

RMO Campaign 2023



The [Australasian College of Dermatologists](#) (ACD) is the organisation accredited to train and assess dermatologists in Australia. Trainees in the program undertake four years of practical training in accredited clinical settings under the supervision of practicing dermatologists.

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued by your allocated training facility, applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an RMO application via the [RMO Campaign applicant portal](#).

RMO application: Step 10 Preferences

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, applicants are advised to enter the combination as displayed:

What is your first preferred facility? *
College/Pathway/Network (Determined)

What is your first preferred position? *
Registrar

What is your first preferred Specialty? *
Dermatology

What is your first preferred Sub-Specialty? *
None (Derm)

As up to 5 preferences may be recorded as part of the application, it is recommended that applicants utilise a lower preference to indicate which positions they may be interested in if they are not selected to your preferred position.
