FKG were awarded the contract for the early works which were completed in August 2018.

FKG optimised opportunities for local businesses by engaging locals for these works when possible.

The early works were carried out to prepare the site for the new buildings and included;

- Construction of new BEMS/Stores Buildings and Central Energy Facility building
- Relocation of services, such as Gas, Power, Data, Fire, Water and Drainage.
- Demolition and relocation of functions for Stores, Laundry and Medical records buildings
- Provide additional parking areas, roadways and walkways
- Establishment of footprint for new hospital building



A smoking ceremony was held at the Kingaroy Hospital Campus in April 2018

Smoking Ceremonies are an ancient Aboriginal custom in which native plants (gum tree/tea tree leaves) are burned to produce smoke to ward off evil spirits, acknowledge ancestors and pay respect to the land and sea of country.

The smoke is believed to have healing and cleansing properties.
