Telehealth is a way of talking to and seeing health professionals from all over Queensland, without travelling too far from home. It is conducted via video link.

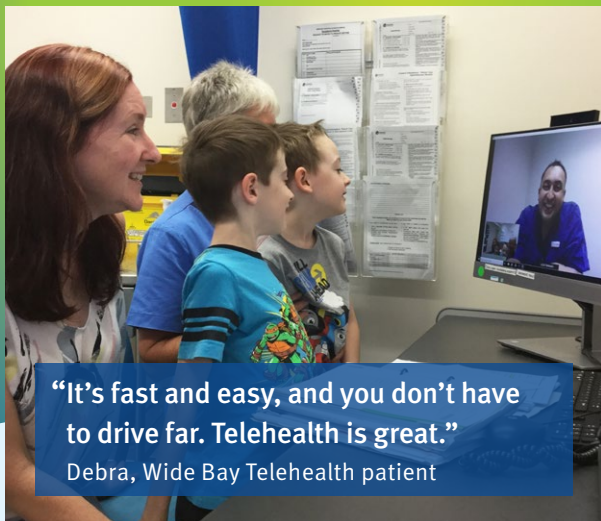
All Wide Bay Hospitals and Multipurpose Health Services are enabled with Telehealth facilities.
