Security upgrades at hospital

Staff and patients of the Millmerran Multipurpose Health Service (MPHS) are in safe hands thanks to recent security upgrades.

Director of Nursing Cath Frame said an occupational violence risk assessment had revealed some gaps in the facility's security.

"Security doors have been installed in the front and rear entry of the hospital and are now locked at all times," Ms Frame said.

"Visitors may find it inconvenient, but these measures show that we take safety seriously.

"On arrival visitors can use the call bell and a staff member will meet them and open door.

"These doors will ensure that patients, visitors and staff are safe at all times."
