RMO application: Step 10 Preferences

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, to be considered by the Endocrinology Advanced Training Program, new applicants **MUST** complete the first preference as follows:

What is your first preferred facility? *

College/Pathway/Network (Determined)

What is your first preferred position? *

Registrar

What is your first preferred Specialty? *

Medicine

What is your first preferred Sub-Specialty? *

Endocrinology (Med) (AT)

Once you have completed your preferences, in the text box below **new applicants must also** indicate, in order of personal interest, the facilities they are willing to work in (1 being the highest). **DO NOT** list a facility if you are not willing to accept a position.
