



# COLD CHAIN BREACH REPORTING FORM

- This form is used to report a cold chain breach (CCB) where the temperature in the fridge used to store vaccines has gone outside the temperature range of between +2°C and +8°C (excludes fluctuations up to +12°C lasting no longer than 15 minutes).
- The person who noted the cold chain breach should complete this form.
